### Divine Mercy Sunday

**April 7th at 3:00 PM at Saint Anthony Church**

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Confessions,  
Divine Mercy Chaplet, Benediction

Jesus said, *"My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given to you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet. When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one. Write that when they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the Just Judge but as the Merciful Savior (Diary, 1541)."*

On Divine Mercy Sunday, the Graces received wipe away all temporal punishment up to that point. This Grace is given by God. The Plenary indulgence is for a deceased person. This indulgence is given by the Church. The requirements to receive the Graces and indulgence are:

- 1) On Divine Mercy Sunday, receive Holy Communion.
- 2) Receive Sacramental Confession within 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.
- 3) Prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (usually an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be)
- 4) Must have no attachment to sin, even venial sin, in order for the indulgence to be Plenary.


