

### Divine Mercy Sunday April 7th at 3:00 PM at Saint Anthony Church

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Confessions, Divine Mercy Chaplet, Benediction

Jesus said, "My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given to you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet. When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one. Write that when they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the Just Judge but as the Merciful Savior (Diary, 1541)."

On Divine Mercy Sunday, the Graces received wipe away all temporal punishment up to that point. This Grace is given by God. The Plenary indulgence is for a deceased person. This indulgence is given by the Church. The requirements to receive the Graces and indulgence are:

- 1) On Divine Mercy Sunday, receive Holy Communion.
- 2) Receive Sacramental Confession within 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.
- 3) Prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (usually an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be)
- 4) Must have no attachment to sin, even venial sin, in order for the indulgence to be Plenary.




