PAYMENT OPTIONS

A completed, signed tuition agreement and registration fee of \$50 must be on file for each enrolled student. Registration fee is due on or before May 30th. First tuition payment is due on or before September 15th. We offer three payment options. <u>Please check one:</u>

- 1. **One-payment plan.** Payment in full on or before September 15. A 1.5% discount will be taken off of line 4 if tuition is paid in full by this date. If received after September 15th, the discount will be removed, sorry no exceptions.
- 2. *Two-payment plan*. First payment due on or before September 15th and second payment due on February 15th.
- 3. _____Monthly payment plan First payment due on or before September 15th. Payments two through nine (October through May) are due on the 15th of each month or on a date of your choice ______. (Will be the same every month)

St. Anthony School strives to make Catholic education accessible to everyone. If the above options do not fit the particular needs of your family, please remember the following:

- Families may make special arrangements with the Principal for an alternative tuition plan, which would replace the above plans. This arrangement will be put in writing and signed by the Principal and the family.
- If you are experiencing temporary financial difficulties that may affect your current payment plan, please contact the office immediately to discuss an alternative payment plan. Payments would otherwise be considered late.
- Needs-based scholarships are available. Should you need any sort of assistance, please contact the Principal. This matter is kept completely confidential.

TUITION COLLECTION POLICIES

- Students will not be admitted on the first day of school unless the \$50 registration fee is paid. Outstanding balances will not be carried over from one year to the next. All payments for the current school year must be made by the end of May.
- ✦ If tuition payments are late beyond 30 days without an alternative plan put in place, a \$5.00 per day fee will be assessed until the payment has been made.
- ◆ If payments are not received by the school on or before the due date, the following actions will take place.

FUNDRASING OBLIGATION

As you can see from above, tuition only covers a portion of the total cost to educate each St. Anthony student. Therefore, it is very important to put significant effort into our fundraising activities. This is what helps us to keep tuition low. The St. Anthony Home and School Team (HST) works diligently in overseeing all fundraising events and efforts. Parents of St. Anthony students are automatically members of this Team.

The goals of the HST are to ensure the future of St. Anthony School, to enhance the relationships between students, staff, family and parishes, and to raise the remaining funds to cover the *current* year's total cost for educating St. Anthony students. *Each 5K-5th grade family has an obligation to participate in these fundraising opportunities by working 20 hours of fundraising time or to pay a Fundraising Obligation Fee of \$500.00 per family. A 4K grade family has an obligation to participate by working 15 hours of fundraising time or pay a Fundraising Obligation Fee of \$375.00 per family.*

FUNDRASING OBLIGATION POLICIES

A. Each 5K-5th grade family must contribute 20 hours of fundraising time. 4K parents must contribute 15 hours.

B. All fundraising time for the current school year must be completed - or scheduled to be completed - and documented with a Home and School representative no later than May 1.

C. If a family completes only a portion of the required hours, the remaining hours will be prorated and converted into a Fundraising Obligation Fee. This fee *will then follow the tuition collection policy* and must be paid **by May 31st.**

D. 5K-5th grade families choosing not to work 20 hours will pay a Fundraising Obligation Fee of \$500.00 per family. 4k families would pay a fee of \$375.00. This fee will be treated as part of tuition.

Here are some ways to earn hours:

1. Volunteer for a fundraiser

2. Sell items

3. Lunch Room Supervision (Need 1 Person Daily) from 10:55am-12:05pm (helping students open food items, providing supervision in the lunch area.) (No Kitchen Duties assigned) <u>Need to be Virtus & Background checked.</u>

4. Recess Aide (Need 1 Person Daily) to help the Recess Person out on the playground. <u>Need to be Virtus & Background</u> <u>Checked.</u>

5. Athletic coaching (Need to be Virtus & Background Checked), serving as a Home & School Officer, serving on the Total Board of Education

6. Service Hours- These are not tied to the monetary commitment, but allow you to give back to the school and community, and are so greatly appreciated. (Some examples of these include: organizing the Memorial Day Parade, attending school meetings, helping in a classroom (Need to be Virtus & Background Checked) and helping with Catholic Schools Week events.)

There will be some events throughout the year that will provide opportunities to earn fundraising hours by selling raffle tickets. Refer to the yearly fundraising packet that Home and School provides in the beginning of the school year to get the details of how many hours can be earned selling. The packet will also have a list of events that will take place throughout the school year.
