

Let's Talk Preschool Tuition

Tuition at St. Anthony Preschool for the 2018-2019 school year is:

- + 2 Days a Week Session \$740.00 for estimated 73 sessions running 2 days a week from 8:00-11am. This equals \$10.14 per session or \$3.38 per hour.**
- + 3 Days a Week Session \$890.00 for estimated 104 session running 3 days a week from 8:00-11am. This equals \$8.56 per session or \$2.85 per hour.**

Ways for families to reduce their tuition costs:

SCRIP- Scrip is a term that means "substitute money". When you purchase scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift cards that are used just like cash. You can use scrip to purchase everyday expenses like food, gas, clothing, and other essentials. With every purchase, you earn revenue for your child's tuition. Half of all rebates "profit" generated from purchasing gift cards, through the scrip program, will go towards your child's tuition. We encourage you to invite relatives and friends to participate, as they can apply their rebates to your families account. How does it work? St. Anthony buys the scrip from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a discount, and re-sells the gift cards to families like yours for full face value. Average discounts range from two to fifteen. For example: If you purchase a Piggly Wiggly \$100 gift card with a 3% profit, \$1.50 will be applied to your tuition and the school earns \$1.50. If you purchase a Cabela's \$100 gift card with an 11% profit, \$5.50 will be applied to your tuition and the school earns \$5.50. See the order form for a list of retailers available.
